## **GATE CODE.....**

(This will be given to campers but not day visitors and please do not pass this code onto anyone else)

Let us start by reminding all visitors that clothing **MUST** be worn in the car park, no exceptions, as when the gate is open drivers going past can see into the club!!!

This applies only to the main carpark, not the rear of the club house.

If you take your car to a site for unloading it **MUST** be returned to the car park as soon as possible

The club has 40 day chalets and 20 Static caravans, which are privately owned, around the grounds and we also have space for 10 caravan/camper hookups plus areas for tent camping. There is a limited number of electric hook ups for tents.

## **THE CLUBHOUSE**

In the clubhouse you will find our notice board and the list of committee members.

There are also changing room lockers, washing machine, (*available at a small charge*) sauna, and hot tub room, toilets including a disabled toilet and the showers, plus of course our socials venue which has small lounge area with TV and a library for you to use.



## **THE GAMES ROOM**

The games room has a small snooker table, table top shuffleboard and various games for adults and children, plus we keep the freezers in there if you wish to utilise them (please label your packages)



## KITCHENS

We have 2 kitchens, one is only accessible by committee members. However the members kitchen is available for everyone to use and is fully fitted. Visitors are welcome to use the fridge. Please clean up after yourself and take all rubbish home as we do not have a refuse collection service. Please do not put any fat into our sinks, use the green fat collectors in the kitchen areas.

## THE SAUNA

The sauna is only available on a Friday evening. Please do not switch this on at any other time. The Jacuzzi is available at any time provided there is no signage advising of its closure. For health and safety reasons we request no lone bathers and no breakables.



## Noise

Respect your fellow members and guests, especially late at night. If you make any mess, please tidy it up as we don't have any cleaners on site. Thank you !!



## THE CLUB

( a few "requests" to help us keep everyone safe

and secure when using the facilities – we don't like rules !!!)

**Towels** – it is common courtesy that as naturists we carry a towel with us for personal use and to sit on whether using the pool area or any other seated area in the club.

In the grounds of the club you will find our heated open air SWIMMING POOL, and surrounding it there are loungers for use by all visitors and members of the club. Nudity is compulsory in the pool, and please use the shower beside the entrance gate before using the pool.



Please ensure if any non-swimmer wishes to go into the pool, there must be an able bodied swimmer at the poolside. For health and safety reasons, no lone bathers or breakables.

There are camping areas around the pool and in other parts of the club and grassy areas to lay your towel or deck chairs to sunbathe if you prefer that to poolside.



There is a speed limit of 5MPH throughout the club, and please park with care and consideration.



Unfortunately NO PETS are allowed in the club.

**Photography** – in order to preserve everyone's privacy, permission must be obtained from a committee member before taking any pictures and also from the person who is the subject, also if any other persons can be seen in your pictures, they must also give their permission.

**Children** – visitors and members are responsible for their children's safety and behaviour at all times. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a supervising adult at all times while in the pool area and untrained children must wear rubber pants.

### **SPECIAL NOTE**

We have a bio-disc system which only takes the 3 P's....paper, pee and poo !!!  
Please do not put anything else into the sewage system!!



### **Water and waste disposal for caravans and campervans**

The waste disposal area is behind the clubhouse and about 10 yards to the right of the entrance to the car park....(if you walked in the gate you turn sharp right and walk towards the rear of the clubhouse.)

There is a small structure with doors on the front to your left and a hose pipe on the outside.

*(If walking across car park, remember some clothing)*

You can recharge your clean water tanks and there is also a ground level drain for motor homes.
